## KU Four-Year Scholarship

KU has four-year merit scholarships of up to \$9,000 per year beginning with Fall 2018 admission. The annual scholarship amounts available are \$3,000, \$6,000 and \$9,000.

### To be considered for the KU AAP Scholarship you must:

1. Be a first-time freshman
2. Have at least a 3.0 high school GPA at the time of admission (or equivalent in your country)
3. Submit any additional documentation requested by your recruiter

### To renew the scholarship, you must:

- Enroll in at least 15 KU credit hours each fall and spring semester
- Complete a minimum of 30 KU hours each academic year
- Maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA at KU
