

Here are the entrance requirements for all the Australian Foundation programmes which Otago University recognises. Otago University doesn't differentiate bachelor programmes, so as long as the student gains the following they are in:

### **Australian University Foundation Programmes**

- **University of Adelaide Foundation Studies** (Bradford College) – minimum average of 70% / Credit
- **Australian National University (ANU) Foundation** – minimum average 72% (65% or higher in Advanced Academic English meets the English requirement)
- **Curtin University of Technology Foundation** – minimum average of 70% / Distinction / 7
- **La Trobe Foundation Year** – minimum average 80%
- **University of Melbourne Trinity Foundation Year** – minimum average 75%
- **Monash University Foundation Year** – minimum total of 265 across best four subjects (65% or higher in English meets the English requirement) and confirmation of completion of the qualification
- **University of New South Wales** Foundation Programme – minimum GPA 6.5
- **RMIT** – minimum average 80%
- **Swinburne Foundation Year** – minimum average 85%
- **University of Sydney Foundation Programme** – minimum GPA 7.0 (C or higher in English meets the English requirement)
- **Taylor's College** (also offered in New Zealand) – minimum of 270 across best four subjects, excluding English (70% or higher in English meets the English requirement)
- **Western Australian Universities' Preparatory Programme (WAUPP)** – minimum Combined Percentage Score (CPS) of 60, calculated as average of best three subjects (excluding English Language and Australian Cultural Studies)
- **University of Western Australia Foundation Programme (UWAFP)** – minimum 65% average
- **University of Queensland Foundation Year** – minimum GPA 5/7
- **University of Tasmania Foundation Studies programme** – minimum GPA 7/10
