Australian Year 12 Scholarship

- This scholarship assists international students who successfully complete an Australian high school qualification either in Australia or overseas. The scholarship will help students to continue their education in Australia.
- The Australian Year 12 scholarship will provide students 25 per cent of their first year tuition fees for programs at Curtin's Western Australian campuses.
- Students must meet Curtin's entry requirements relevant to your course through completing one of the following:
 - The Australian Capital Territory Year 12 Certificate, either in Australia or overseas.
 - The New South Wales Year 12 High School Certificate, either in Australia or overseas.
 - The Northern Territory Certificate of Education, either in Australia or overseas.
 - The Queensland Certificate of Education, either in Australia or overseas.
 - The South Australian Certificate of Education, either in Australia or overseas.
 - The Tasmanian Certificate of Education, either in Australia or overseas.
 - The Victorian Certificate of Education, either in Australia or overseas.
 - The Western Australian Certificate of Education, either in Australia or overseas.
 - Western Australian Universities' Foundation program (WAUFP).
 - Earlier versions of the above certificates as recognised in Curtin's entry requirements.

Alumni & Family Scholarship

- The scholarship will provide 25 per cent of first year tuition fees.
- The scholarship is available for undergraduate or master by coursework programs at Curtin's Western Australian campuses.
- Only applied in full to Master programs of 400 credits, and only 25% of the first semester of tuition fee for Masters less than 400 credits
- Need to demonstrate that the student or their sibling, half-sibling, parent or child are members of Curtin's alumni, or currently enrolled at Curtin.
- Students with Credit for Recognised Learning (CRL) are not eligible.







Merit Scholarship

- The scholarship will provide 25 per cent of first year tuition fees.
- The scholarship is available for undergraduate or master by coursework programs at Curtin's Western Australian campuses and if students apply for these programs they are automatically assessed for the scholarship.
- Only applied in full to Master programs of 400 credits, and only 25% of the first semester of tuition fee for Masters less than 400 credits.
- Students must meet the higher academic cutoffs as specified by Curtin. Students with Credit for Recognised Learning (CRL) are not eligible. Students with CRL may be eligible for the CRL Merit Scholarship (please refer to our website for terms and conditions and qualifying criteria).







CRL Merit Scholarship


- The scholarship will provide 10 per cent of first year tuition fees.
- The scholarship is available for undergraduate or master by coursework programs at Curtin's Western Australian campuses and if students apply for these programs they are automatically assessed for the scholarship.
- Only applied in full to Master programs of 400 credits, and only 10% of the first semester of tuition fee for Masters less than 400 credits.
- Students must meet the higher academic cutoffs as specified by Curtin. Only for students granted CRL (Credit for Recognised Learning) and enrolled in minimum 300 credits.





MBA International Student Scholarship

- Curtin's MBA International Student Scholarship has been developed to encourage and support students who have chosen to study the Master of Business Administration (MBA) as full-time students at Curtin.
- Receive up to \$15,000* toward your tuition fees for up to 1.5 years study (based on a full-time study load of 75 credits per trimester).
- *Eligibility criteria applies. Please refer to <u>http://www.scholarships.curtin.edu.au</u> for further information.







MBA (Global) Future Leaders Scholarship

- The MBA (Global) Future Leaders Scholarship has been developed to encourage and support academically talented students studying the MBA (Global) at Curtin University.
- This scholarship will provide up to 30 per cent of student tuition fees for the expected duration of the MBA (Global) for up to a maximum of two years (based on a full-time load of 100 credits per semester).
