Splendid USST Dual Bachelor Degrees Programme

Since September 2020, SBC and USST offer students a fantastic and unique opportunity to earn both a British bachelor degree and a Chinese bachelor degree. If international students have a strong desire to learn Chinese, they can be dual enrolled. After four years of study at SBC, students can earn both a British bachelor degree certificate from either the University of Huddersfield, Liverpool John Moores University, or Sheffield Hallam University and a Chinese bachelor degree certificate from the University of Shanghai for Science and Technology (USST).

SBC and USST will provide Chinese lessons and language learning equipment to all students on the Dual Bachelor Degrees Programme. If the students are unable to achieve a Chinese language level of HSK 4 they will not be eligible to graduate from USST but still can graduate with a British bachelor degree.

Single Bachelor Degree Programme

To understand the Single Bachelor Degree Programme of SBC, There are two things we need to clarify.

•What does PATHWAY mean at SBC?

Pathways	In Shanghai at SBC	In the UK
4+0	Four years in Shanghai at SBC, including Foundation Year	No period of study in the UK but there are opportunities to visit
3+0	No Foundation Year Three years in Shanghai at SBC	
2+2	Two years in Shanghai at SBC, including Foundation Year	Final two years in the UK
1+2	No Foundation Year One year in Shanghai at SBC	

Tips: The difference between 4+0 and 3+0 is the entry year of an applicant entering into SBC, if she/he enters into SBC year 1 then the pathway is 4+0 but if it's SBC year 2 then the pathway is 3+0. This rule also applies to pathway of 2+2(1+2).

•What kind of courses will you learn in the first 1 or 2 years at SBC?

International Foundation Year (SBC Year 1)







SBC's International Foundation Year is organized and accredited by the educational charity NCUK. When you complete NCUK's International Foundation Certificate in Business or Engineering, you will have achieved a firm grounding in British University education with a qualification that is accepted across the world. You will also be automatically enrolled in one of SBC's Single Bachelor Degree Programmes.

International Bachelor Degree Year 1 (SBC Year 2)



In both Business and Engineering, SBC's degree year is organized and accredited by NCUK. Students completing this year are guaranteed a place at one of SBC's 9 UK partner Universities or a place on one of SBC's bachelor degree programmes delivered entirely in Shanghai.

•For international applicants of the 4+0(3+0) pathway, four majors are available from which to choose.

These various teaching methods allow students to cultivate essential multidimensional skills, such as problem-solving and critical thinking/writing.

SBC's School of Engineering and Computing keeps pace with the modern requirements of today's complex world of engineering.

SBC utilizes diverse teaching methods, including lectures, tutorials, laboratories, symposiums, and personal design projects. The School of Engineering and Computing helps students attain professional knowledge, improve problem-solving, and develop capabilities in Engineering, manufacturing, etc.



Accommodation

SBC's International Student Accommodation is situated on campus. You will enjoy being in the center of one of the most international, cosmopolitan, and vibrant global cities.

SBC's international accommodation offers incoming students a choice of either two-person rooms or four-person rooms. SBC's campus provides a 24-hour security service, which ensures the safety of all students.

Learning Chinese

Non-Dual Degree International Students are entitled to free Chinese lessons. They are not compulsory and do not factor into the final award classification.

SBC's Chinese language programme follows the HSK system. The longer students study with us, the higher HSK rating they can achieve. HSK 4 is the grade required to enter a Chinese state university and demonstrates a high fluency level.

Career Development

At SBC, training and expertise are offered to all students who would like to find an internship or obtain legal employment in Shanghai. Our Career Service Team enjoys strong relationships with top companies in Shanghai, many of whom send representatives to talk to students on campus. In previous years SBC graduates have worked for; Jebson Motors, Disney, Huawei, KPMG, Standard Chartered, PWC, Saatchi & Saatchi, Accenture, and many more.

Cost of Study

Tuition Fee at SBC:

CNY 80,000 / Year (Same for both Dual Bachelor Degrees Programme and Single Bachelor Degree Programme)

Accommodation Fee at SBC:

CNY 18,000 / Year for shared 2-bed room (including 1 bathroom)

CNY 15,000 / Year for shared 4-bedroom (attic) (including 2 bathrooms in each floor)

NCUK Registration Fee at SBC:

CNY 5,000 / Year (Only students of Single Bachelor Degree Programme need to pay in SBC year 1 and SBC year 2)

Students of Dual Bachelor Degrees Programme do not register with NCUK and therefore do not have to pay any registration fee.

Book Fee

CNY 1,500 / Year (Only SBC year 1 students need to pay)

Insurance Fee

CNY 600 / Year or CNY 800 / Year (Free to choose)

Repeating EAP fee at SBC

CNY 8,000

(This fee applies to an international student of SBC year 2 who doesn't pass EAP course in SBC year 1. Besides, if an SBC-Year-2 applicant doesn't have the IELTS 6.0 or the other equivalent English language qualification, this repeating EAP fee is also required.)

For students of 2+2(1+2) pathway of Single Bachelor Degree Programme, the cost in the UK vary dependent on location and choice of university.
