- For pathway students, the last 10 weeks of their English program at Curtin English will be free of charge, provided they progress to their mainstream program at Curtin University

About Curtin English

- English plus

English Gateway

- General English proficiency, but moving towards academic
- Academic elective for those going directly to University
- Meeting needs of those going to Curtin College
 - o 18 month project with Curtin College
- Curtin Life (English Australia Best Practice Guide)
- Introduction to Study skills

What the students receive

- Free 10 weeks (The last 10 weeks of English English Language Bridging or English Gateway)
- Students can only redeem one free English period.
- If the student is required to repeat, the student will pay for their repeat course. Once the student passes the course, they will receive their first course free.
- Students who only need 10 weeks English in total, also get their enrolment fee waived (\$270)



Who is eligible

- Students who will enter mainstream from 2019 on and will study minimum 1 year.
- This includes <u>all</u> students in ELB Semester 2 and Summer Semester
- Only for students who NEED English (i.e. they have an offer conditional on English)
- Offer available regardless of how long the required English pathway is; so the student pays for everything except the last 10 weeks.
- Offer is available for Curtin College students on a pathway to Curtin University,
- Students who do not have a condition, but wish to study ELB; that's a great idea which will help them get the most out of their mainstream study, but they will have to pay



Conditions

- A deposit is required, to demonstrate true intent to study at Curtin
 - o Regular countries deposit value of 1st Semester mainstream fees
 - o Streamlined countries deposit value of 10 weeks free English.
- The deposit will be credited against the students' tuition fees when they progress to their mainstream course
- Those students who do not progress to mainstream, will be charged for ELB and this fee will be deducted from the deposit paid.
- The standard University refund policy will apply in relation to their mainstream course.
- Curtin College students must progress to their mainstream course to fulfil the criteria for free English
- Their English fees deposit will not be credited against Curtin College fees. It will be held until
 they start their mainstream University course. Then it will be credited against their mainstream
 fees.

FREE ENGLISH LANGUAGE BRIDGING PROGRAM

If you don't meet our English language requirements, you may be eligible for our free, 10-week English Language Bridging Program.

The program is available to all international students who have received an offer to study at Curtin in Perth, who need to improve their English proficiency before beginning their studies. Passing the course satisfies Curtin University's English language requirement.

English Language Bridging is designed to prepare you for success in your chosen course at Curtin University and covers more than just English. As well as speaking, listening, reading, writing, grammar and vocabulary, it includes lessons in studying effectively, academic referencing, critical thinking and how to contribute to discussions in an academic context.

It also provides an introduction to Curtin's course outlines and student systems, and includes faculty tours.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

International students who have received an offer to study at Curtin University in Perth, which is conditional on meeting Curtin's English requirement.

Students who wish to study the program but already meet Curtin's minimum English requirements (i.e. there is no condition on their offer) are welcome to do so, but program fees apply.

If you require more than 10 weeks' English tuition to meet our requirements, fees apply for the extra tuition.

All Curtin English programs can be packaged with your mainstream course for visa applications.


