





Student Accommodation

Process Payment Instalment plan



- To apply for accommodation, click the link <https://hoswebvm.ads.qub.ac.uk/apply/>
- Payment of the £300 accommodation deposit confirms acceptance of your accommodation offer. This amount converts to a damage deposit and is held on your accommodation account for the length of your contract. This is not a pre-payment and not included in the residential fees. Deposit will be refunded when student check out the accommodation and will be refunded by bank transfer.
- For International Students accepting a contract for 40, 48 or 51 weeks starting in September the following payment options are available:
 - a) Full payment: before or at check-in.
 - b) 2 instalments: 50% of your accommodation fee before or at check-in, the balance being payable by 1st February.
 - c) 1 instalment payment and 3 direct debit instalments. 25% instalment must be paid before or at check-in and three equal direct debit payments are made on 1st January, 1st February and 1st March.

English (Syllabus A) with a score of 4 at Standard Level or 4 at Higher Level will normally meet the English language entry requirement for the majority of our programmes. English (Syllabus B) with a score of 5 at Standard Level or 4 at Higher Level is also acceptable. English language requirements may vary depending on your chosen programme. Entry Requirement Academic Postgraduate

Normally requires either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses, major subject or content of the Bachelor degree may also be considered

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1) = GPA 3.0/4 - 3.2/4

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2) = GPA 2.8/4 - 2.9/4

Students who do not meet the requirement may consider Graduate Diploma at INTO Queen's major in Finance, Management and Social Science
