Computer Systems Core: 27 credits

- Managing Technology Projects
- Computer Architecture
- Software Testing

- Information Security Overview/Secure Systems and Programs

Depth of Study Sequence: 9 credits - Information Security

Capstone: 3 credits

In the Capstone experience, students apply what they have learned in the form of a thesis or a project completed under the guidance of an advisor. Students choose their own Capstone based on their interests and depth-of-study sequences.

Total Coursework: 39 credits

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. International student application form
- **2.** \$50 application fee
- **3.** Original or certified copies of diplomas and transcripts (with certified English translations)
- **4.** Proof of English language proficiency
- **5.** Consent to release information (if applying through CityU's approved agents)
- 6. Copy of passport

- **7.** Bank statement and financial declaration form, plus sponsor statement, if applicable
- **8.** After arrival in the U.S.: Copies of I-94, visa, and entry stamp
- **9.** For transfer students coming from another U.S. college: International student transfer evaluation form and copies of I-20s
- **10.** Additional requirements may apply depending on program and start date.

ADMISSIONS PORTFOLIO CONSISTING OF:

- Documentation supporting knowledge or experience in the following areas (college coursework as documented on a transcript, documented training, and/or detailed explanation of work experience):
 - Equivalency of ten quarter credits at the intermediate level in at least one computer programming language
 - Equivalency of five quarter credits in networking (TCP/IP from physical through applications layer)
 - Equivalency of five quarter credits of data management including basic database design and SQL/Queries
