Course length:

5 years full time including International Foundation Year.

Entry requirements:

IELTS entry requirement (5.5 in all skills) and minimum Mathematics at grade C (or 4) or Naric equivalent.

Progression requirements:

Student must achieve an overall grade of at least 70% to progress to the MPharm degree. IELTS testing will also be required on completion of the International Foundation Year, where students must achieve IELTS 6.5 with no less than 6.0 in each skill. An interview with Kingston University will also be required.
