scholarships

SCHOLARSHIPS BASED ON ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT	VALUE IN \$CAD
International Student Entrance Scholarships (limited number)	\$10,000 for one year
Waterloo Faculty Entrance Scholarships (limited number)	\$500 for one year to \$80,000 over 4 years
President's and Merit Scholarships	\$1,000-\$2,000 for your first year
President's Scholarship of Distinction	\$2,000 for your first year, plus up to \$3,000 available in upper years

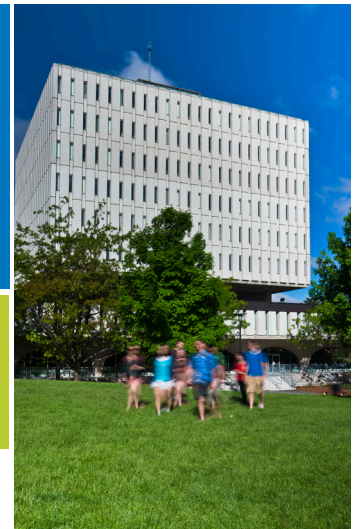

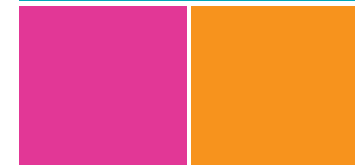
