






Graduate Program Requirements

- **Solution** Three or four year bachelor's degree
- \oslash No GRE or GMAT required
- **87 iBT TOEFL, 6.5 IELTS, 59 PTE, or 4.0 ITEP**
- MBA: One additional foundation course is required for students without an undergraduate degree in business
- Computer Science: Requires either an undergraduate degree in Computer Science or work experience in the field
- Counseling: Letters of recommendation and personal statement required

Assisted MBA program

English-Language Assisted MBA

This unique program allows students who have slightly lower English proficiency scores to start MBA classes along with English classes.

- English proficiency requirements: TOEFL iBT 76, IELTS 6.0, or PTE 51
- English and MBA classes taken at the same time for two quarters
- MBA program can still be completed in 2 years

Undergraduate Requirements

- At least one year of completed college-level courses. City University of Seattle does NOT have first-year undergraduate classes. Students must transfer with one year or more of completed classes.
- \odot No SAT/ACT required
- **11** 76 iBT TOEFL, 6.0 IELTS, 51 PTE, or 3.5 ITEP
- Students can transfer from most community colleges
- Students can transfer from overseas colleges without WES/ECE evaluations

Application Process

- •Application and application fee (\$50)
- •Original/certified transcripts/diploma (must be mailed)
- •English proficiency scores
- •Financial Declaration form and bank statement / sponsor statement
- •Release of Information form
- Passport copy



Application Process

Master of Science in Computer Science – students need to submit these additional items:

- Program Admission Request form
- Resume

Master of Arts in Counselling – students need to submit these additional items:

- Three references
- Writing sample
- Resume
- Completed background check forms
- Interview (Skype OK)



Application Mistakes!

- Application must have student information only (addresses and email especially)
- Student must sign forms themselves
- Immediate family (parents) do not need to complete sponsor forms
- Transcripts must show degree and date of issue
- Provisional degrees are not accepted, even for conditional acceptance. Official/certified degrees are required.
- Include an agent cover letter and release of information form

•Photos

- •Primary/secondary school transcripts
- •Letters of reference (except for MA Counseling)
- •Essays (except for MA Counseling)
- •ACT/SAT/GRE/GMAT scores
