Health degrees

MPharm Pharmacy

Learn about all aspects of the pharmaceutical industry, from understanding the development and design of drugs to investigating the role of pharmacists in society.

- Accredited by the General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC)
- Four years, full-time
- Learn via work placements throughout the course
- Progress to a career as a pharmacist or health care professional, or go on to further study.



BSc (Hons) Sports Science

Covers physiology, psychology, and biomechanics to help you become a sports psychologist or sports scientist.

- Three years full-time
- Students are taught by lecturers who are experts in their fields
- Guaranteed 154 hour work placement in your second year
- Benefit from excellent, on-campus facilities (Biomechanics, Physiology and nutrition labs and the new sport and fitness centre)
- This course scored 97% for learning resources (National Student Survey 2016)



BSc (Hons) Podiatry

Train to become a Podiatrist – a healthcare professional who assesses and treats the lower limb and foot.

- Three years, full-time
- Specialist, on-campus facilities:
 - fully-equipped Podiatry Clinic
 - surgical theatre suite
 - gait analysis equipment
 - orthotics laboratory
- Guaranteed NHS placements throughout the course.
- Progress to a career as a podiatric surgeon or forensic podiatrist (or undertake further study)



BSc (Hons) Physiotherapy

Gain an in-depth understanding of how our muscles, joints and bones work together to make us move, and start a career as a physiotherapist.

- Accredited by the Chartered Society of Physiotherapists, regulated by the Health and Care Professions Council
- Three years full-time
- Guaranteed work placements throughout the course
- 100% of graduates from this course go onto work/further study within six months of graduating (2016-17)
