Dear Colleague,

There is a lot of information in the press at the moment about changes to immigration rules for international students planning to study in the UK. These changes are being introduced over the next few weeks and months and will impact on FE and HE in different ways. Below is a summary of the changes and the anticipated impact.

Removal of the right to work from 3 August	Will apply to new T4 students applying to study at publically funded FE Colleges. Restricting students from extending their Tier 4 (General) visa or switching to other points-based routes from 12 November	Will apply to all college students unless an 'embedded college offering pathway programmes' to prepare students for entry to a HE course	This will not apply to T4 students in HE extending their visa or moving on to further courses
	College students will need to leave the UK following their course and apply for a new visa overseas if they wish to continue their studies in the UK	
Increased maintenance requirements and the removal of the established presence provision from 12 November Restricting dependants right to work from 12 November	Tier 4 students from outside London will need to show access to £1015 pcm for up to 9 months (£9135) when applying for a T4 visa	Tier 4 students from outside London will need to show access to £1015 pcm for up to 9 months (£9135) when applying for a T4 visa Only able to undertake skilled work on a T4

The key thing to note at this stage is that most of the changes will impact on FE rather than HE and, for the changes that impact on HE (highlighted in green), most will be introduced from 12 November 2015, so will not affect students starting with us in September/October.
