F. Application procedures

1. Submit application and supporting document via Shorelight portal:

2. If student does not have a TOEFL/IELTS results yet, they may choose to do free Itep test. Please schedule a test date with Shorelight rep.
3. CLO will be released only if the student has submitted TOEFL/IELTS/Itep results
4. Make an interview appointment with Shorelight rep if student wants to get scholarship. Scholarship certificate is usually released in few days after the interview.
5. Students usually have around 5 days to accept the scholarship after the scholarship certificate is released. They do so by paying a non-refundable deposit of US\$ 2,000
6. If student managed to get a higher TOEFL/IELTS results, even after paying deposit, he can request to be moved to ID/higher program
7. Complete the rest of the documents in order to get the I-20
