

USA Institution : Edmonds College

A. LOCATION

City : Lynwood (30 mins North of Seattle by car, around 1 hour by bus. From downtown, go to Lynwood transit center and then change bus to Edmonds)

State : Washington

Nearby airport(s) : Seattle-Tacoma International airport

Attraction : Space Needle and Pike Market (both in Seattle downtown), mount Rainier. Alderwood mall is only 25 min by bus from campus. Edmonds is also close to beach

School size: 10,000 (including 1,200 international students)

B. UNIQUE SELLING POINTS (rank, unique program, etc)

- Accept students who have not completed high school. Edmonds offers HS Completion
- Have on-campus dormitories for students ≥ 16 years old
- Students can opt to complete the High School Diploma only without doing the AA degree
- Can accept students from 15 yo if they have HS Diploma/IGCSE

C. Admission Requirements for HS Completion/Associate Degree Course

Intakes: Jan, Apr, Jul, Sep

Minimum academic score/GPA

- If the student is ≥ 16 yo, there's no minimum score. For marketing purpose, to avoid potential students underestimating Edmonds, please tell them that they need to at least have a passing grade.
- If the student is 15 yo and have IGCSE : must have 5 subjects including English & Math. Min scores are C.

Minimum age : 15 yo if the students have HS Diploma/IGCSE, else the student must be 16 yo by the 10th school day at Edmonds.

Note: Indonesian students usually do 15 credits per quarter (3 courses)

E. Housing Options

- On campus residential – Rainier Place and Triton Court (opening soon in 2020). Starting Fall 2020, these residenceals would accommodate students ≥ 16 yo
(previously, students must be ≥ 17 yo to stay here)
- Homestay
- Apartment/other housing options : Off campus residential – Spencer Court & Sophie Court

F. Application procedures

1. Submit the application online via <https://www.edcc.edu/International/admissions/form.html>
2. The \$50 application fee is waived for SUN students. Please write “waived by Sandra” on the form. However, students still have to pay the USD 40 for I-20 mailing
3. For students below 18 yo, parents must sign a Consent to Medical Care and Treatment of Minor Children

Note: Edmonds allows SUN to assist students with dual citizenship of USA and Indonesia, as long as they enroll in regular program (not the government-subsidized programs)

G. Other useful information

There are Asian restaurants at walking distance from campus. Some students also subscribe to Indonesian catering (check with senior Indonesian students for contacts)

There is an orientation program for parents too, which includes shopping to nearest Factory Outlet
