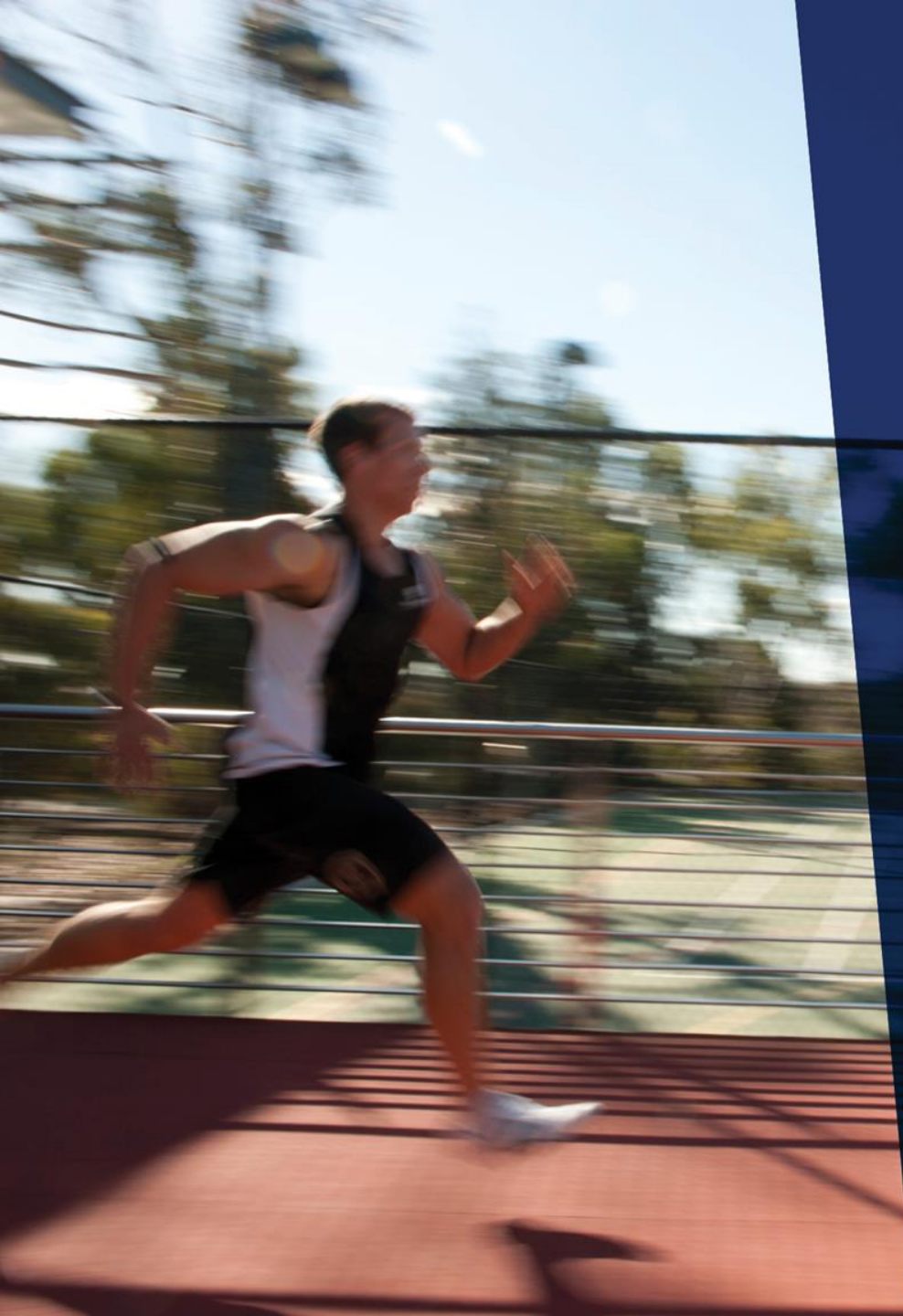

SMA 3	Average score of 8 in academic subjects or higher
GCE A Levels	Minimum of 6 points taken from the best 2 or 3 subjects where A*=6, A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1 (AS Levels are equivalent to half points e.g. A=2.5, B=2 etc.) or higher
International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma	Total score of 24 or higher
French Baccalaureate	Grade average of 10 or higher
Other ways to qualify for entry	Successful completion of one of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A recognised post-secondary (post high school) course. • University preparation (foundation) studies. • One year study at a recognised tertiary or higher education institution. • 2 units completed at an Australian University or Open Universities Australia (OUA)

If you don't meet any of these academic entry requirements, there are a variety of **alternative pathways** you can take to help you qualify for a course. When applying to study at Murdoch University you may be eligible for **credits or exemptions from some course units** based on previous studies or work experience.

English entry requirements

All students must satisfy Murdoch University's minimum English requirements by demonstrating competency in the English Language.

Number:	Multiple scholarships are available
Value:	\$10,000 for all Business and Governance eligible degree courses \$7,000 for all other eligible degree courses
Closes:	To be considered for a scholarship, applications for entry to an eligible course need to be submitted to the international admissions office at least two weeks prior to the start of the semester that the student intends to commence their studies at Murdoch.
Payment:	Subject to the terms and conditions of the award being met, the award will be applied in two equal instalments directly into the recipient's Murdoch University tuition fee account before the start of each of the first two consecutive semesters of study. There is no financial payout of this scholarship, nor is it refundable.
Eligibility:	<p>To be eligible for the scholarship, students must meet all three of the below eligibility criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
