Terms and conditions

Scholarships are limited and provided at the Universities discretion for students commencing in 2021 or 2022. Academic conditions apply for the Design, Business and Health merit based scholarships. Regional scholarships are provided based on new International student passport. Offshore Online Scholarship applicable to students studying the duration of their course offshore. Health Science 20% scholarship applicable to new Japanese applicants only. Sri Lankan Offshore Business scholarship applicable to offshore applicants only. Africa Scholarship is only applicable to new applications received from July 1 2020 onwards. Asia and Greater China Business and Health Merit Scholarship is limited, undergraduate students need to display credit average from high school and postgraduate students need to display a credit average in previous degree. Laureate International Universities Alumni Scholarship is applicable to students who have completed study with a Laureate International University outside of Australia or New Zealand. Scholarships are not applicable to Diploma or Bachelor of Nursing, Blue Mountains International College of Hotel Management (apart from the three pillars scholarship) and Southern School of Natural Therapies course offerings. International students must maintain a full-time study load, 1 EFTSL over 12 month study period to maintain their scholarship. Scholarship applicable on tuition fee only and on first attempt subjects. Full price charged on retake subjects if previously failed. Scholarship may not be eligible for any course changes during the duration of study. Torrens University Australia or Think Education may increase fees each calendar year by up to 10% and fees quoted in offer letters are an approximate only. As an international student in Australia, you may be eligible for a 15% Alternative Study Path Scholarship if you have completed onshore an English language program, Year 12 high school certificate, vocational program or six months of higher education study (unless a letter of release from your current registered provider is obtained, or may be in the process of applying for a Student Visa onshore in Australia). This offer is not available to current students of Torrens University Australia or Think Colleges nor can it be used in conjunction with any other offer or scholarship. Your eligibility for the Alternative Study Path Scholarship remains at the sole and absolute discretion of Torrens University Australia or Think Colleges (as applicable).
