City : Shoreline (25 mins North of Seattle by car, 45 mins by bus. Bus no 5 goes to downtown)

State : Washington

### B. UNIQUE SELLING POINTS (rank, unique program, etc)

- Accept students who have not completed high school. Shoreline offers HS Completion and GED (paket C)
- Rigorous academic program, good preparation for university
- Have on campus dormitory for students > 17 years old
- Std can do practice test before doing the real placement test
- Good academic advisor team for international students, consist of 6 counselors who are very attentive to students
- Have a learning center for Math, Biology, Chemistry, and writing that are taught by faculty. Other than that students can get free 2 hours/week tutoring in each class they take, taught by senior students.
- Every Tuesday, representative from University of Washington will come to give transfer advise

### C. Admission Requirements to Associate Degree

**Intakes:** Jan, March, Jul, Sep

**Minimum academic s core/GPA :** no minimum score, all community colleges in USA has open enrollment. However, to avoid potential students underestimating Shoreline, please tell them that they need to have at least a passing grade.
