Realistically, you may advise parents or students to use <u>bank cheque or bank draft</u> and mail it to our Finance Team. Prior to mailing it, you might want to scan the bank cheque or bank draft and email it to our <u>admissions.mail@sydney.edu.au</u>.

Another alternative is to advise parents or students to use <u>Western Union</u>. You may scan the receipt and email to <u>admissions.mail@sydney.edu.au</u>.

The implication above applies to full-fee paying students. For sponsored students, it is a usual to send Guarantee Letter from the sponsor to accept the offer.

We fully understand that most parents will prefer direct / telegraphic transfer payment. Please be assured that we are working on this and hopefully we will hear good news from our Finance Team. However, until further update and notice from us, kindly refer to payment methods on the link above.
