When to apply

Undergraduate Applications

Semester 1 (February start): 31st October Semester 2 (July start): 31st March

Postgraduate Applications

At least 6 months before the intended start date.

PhD and master's research students may begin their studies at any time during the year with the approval of their supervisor.

You should apply as early as possible to give yourself maximum preparation time for visa application, fee payment, travel and accommodation arrangements. Late applications may be processed, but we cannot guarantee that a decision will be made in time for you to make the necessary arrangements to start your studies here.
