Dear Novi,

Thank you for your ongoing support of Western Sydney University and your strong track record in recruitment and visa approvals. Western Sydney University is pleased to offer your agency authority to conduct Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) assessments as outlined below. Note, this authority is limited to WSU offers for direct admission or WSU ELICOS packaged offers; it does not apply for any other package offers.

Your Agency will:

- complete WSU GTE 2 form to screen the applicant;
- collate and upload to Studylink approved financial supporting documents and sponsorship documents, as appropriate;
- liaise with Western Sydney University Regional Manager and Admissions and Compliance in Sydney to review and improve GTE processes in response to any visa rejection; and
- refer more complex applications with a potential higher risk of visa refusal to Western Sydney University Regional Manager or Admissions for GTE assessment. This would include applications with a gap in study, over 30 for postgraduate and over 24 for undergraduate, unrelated field of study and family ties to Australia. A Statement of Purpose is required for these applications.

Western Sydney University will:

- accept uploaded GTE documents and process applications within 2 working days
- monitor the agency's visa success rate in consultation with agency. In the event of a visa refusal, Western Sydney University Admissions and Compliance will review the student's application, all supporting documents and the DHA decision record;
- consult with the agency and recommend improvements to the agency's GTE screening processes where a visa refusal is considered justified. In future Statements of Purpose could be required to improve visa outcomes;
- immediately review the Authority following two consecutive visa rejections. The University can rescind the agency's GTE approval authority at any time. A visa success rate of 95% in a 6-month period is expected; and

- assess more complex applications as defined above.

We are confident that these arrangements will improve the responsiveness to prospective students and anticipate strong growth in enrolments.
