1. Applicants must meet the eligibility requirements set out for this Scholarship as listed on the front of this form.
2. Applicants will be assessed according to the criteria set out for this Scholarship listed on the front of this form.
3. Applicants will be assessed through interview by a panel of selected industry and academic representatives.
4. Recipients must agree to become ambassadors of Le Cordon Bleu, undertaking activities agreed as reasonable and acceptable by the Scholarship recipient and Le Cordon Bleu including: attending recruitment events; answering enquiries of prospective students; and contributing short articles and images for newsletters and blogs.
5. The Scholarship is not transferable and the recipient must commence in either July 2016 or January 2017.
6. The Scholarship recipient must be enrolled on a full-time basis.
7. The recipient must successfully meet the study requirements of each stage of the program and adhere to program rules in order to be awarded each consecutive period of fee waiver.
8. If the Scholarship recipient fails any subject during the program they are financially responsible for any re-enrolment costs and fees.
9. The Scholarship is a tuition fee waiver or reduction only.
10. Recipients will be liable to pay any non-tuition fee items which may be required for the program.
