Why study the IPM?

Route to success

Over the last three years, IPM students have gone on to study at UCL, LSE, the University of Warwick, the University of Manchester, and other leading UK universities.

Exceptional preparation

In 2021, 95% of IPM students went on to achieve a merit or distinction in their UCL Master's.

Personal support

A one-to-one tutorial every week with your personal tutor as well as regular support from the course leaders.

Applying

The application deadlines are as follows:

- September entry: 26 August 2022
- January entry: 9 December 2022

We will close applications before this date if the course is full, so you are encouraged to apply early.

Entry requirements

To be considered for the IPM, you will need to meet both our:

- Academic entry requirements
- English language entry requirements

Academic entry requirements

You must normally show that you have a strong academic background by having a minimum of a lower second-class degree (2:2) or an overseas equivalent.

English language requirements

You must show that your English is sufficient for the course.

September 2022 entry

- > IELTS Academic: 5.5 overall & in each section
- > TOEFL iBT: 72 overall, 17 in listening & writing, 18 in reading, 20 in speaking
- > PTE Academic: 59 overall & in each section
- > Cambridge English Scale: 162 overall & in each section

January 2023 entry

- > IELTS Academic: 6.0 overall & in each section
- > TOEFL iBT: 80 overall, 19 in listening & writing, 20 in reading, 22 in speaking
- > PTE Academic: 65 overall & in each section
- > Cambridge English Scale: 169 overall & in each section

For both entry points

Your English language qualification must be less than two years old from IPM start date. We do not accept degrees taught in English as meeting our English language requirement.
