

UK progression scholarships 2018–19

Our best-performing students can qualify for a progression scholarship for their degree tuition fees. These scholarships are awarded jointly with our partner universities, to students who finish their pathway course during the 2018–19 academic year.

		LIC First Class Scholarship For undergraduate students who have progressed from LIC, and who achieve an overall average of 70% in any year of study at the University of Liverpool (excluding final year). £1,000 award will be deducted from tuition fees for the following year.
