Murdoch University research is focussed on international development, strong communities and solving the intractable problems associated with food security, health and sustainable development. We are proud to be a research-led University, committed to meeting global challenges through innovation and inspired thinking. For more than two decades, the Asia Research Centre has been an international leader in the study of East and Southeast Asia, undertaking fundamental disciplinary and interdisciplinary research examining a range of social, political, historical, environmental and economic forces and developments within this dynamic region.

The quality of research undertaken by academics in Murdoch's Asia Research Centre and Schools of Business and Governance, Arts, and Veterinary and Life Sciences, is reflected in the 2015 Excellence in Research for Australia rankings for Politics, History and Environmental Management of 4 (above world standard) and 3 (at world standard), equating to 87 per cent of our research rated as world-class standard or higher.

In addition, QS places Murdoch in its top 200 institutions for Politics, and Agriculture and Forestry (including Fisheries) and the top 50 for Veterinary Science.

# > Think globally connected


Ranked 33 in the Times Higher Education Top 100 Most International Universities in the world gives us an edge with our diverse staff and student community.

#### Part-time work

If you are an international student studying on a student visa, you may be eligible to work part-time for up to 40 hours per fortnight and unlimited hours during your semester breaks.

#### Living expenses

As a general guide, you should budget approximately AUD\$500\* per week for living expenses in Perth and approximately AUD\$150\* to \$400\* per semester for textbooks and other incidental costs related to studying. \*Study course duration is two years when this course is packaged with a Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma program, if required for entry.

To be eligible for a Murdoch Postgraduate Coursework degree, you will need to have an IELTS score of 6.0 or equivalent. To be eligible for a Murdoch Postgraduate Research degree, you will need to have an IELTS score of 6.5 or equivalent.

### > Indonesian students on campus

Led by a very strong team of undergraduate and postgraduate students, the Murdoch University Indonesian Students Association (MUISA) is one of the most active student groups on the Perth campus, serving to elevate awareness of their homeland and its cultural traditions among fellow students and staff. MUISA are actively involved in a myriad of activities every year, including but not limited to; Murdoch's Multicultural Festival, Lebaran celebrations, Indonesia Merdeka Day, Iftar gatherings and the University Open Days. They have also contributed significantly to the broader Western Australian community in spreading awareness about the uniqueness of Indonesian culture, through the MUISA angklong group which runs classes for the public, and through Indonesian cultural workshops that they regularly present at high schools and state level multicultural events.
