





Dear Colleagues,

We wish to inform you that the organisation that accredits Glion Institute of Higher Education and Les Roches Global Hospitality Education has changed its name. The Commission on Institutions of Higher Education of the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (CIHE-NEASC) is now known as the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE).

What will change?

- All higher education institutions previously accredited by CIHE-NEASC (both in the US and abroad) are now accredited by NECHE.
- We need to replace all Glion and Les Roches references to CIHE-NEASC accreditation with NECHE and the NECHE logo:
 - Digital collateral to be updated by the end of October
 - Print collateral to be updated by the next scheduled reprint

What stays the same?

 Accreditation standards, policies and procedures are unaffected by this development.

What's the difference between NECHE and NEASC?

- NECHE and NEASC are separate and independent organisations.
 CIHE-NEASC no longer exists.
- NECHE accredits higher education institutions only.
- NEASC accredits K-12/non-degree granting institutions only (NEASC includes the Committee on Technical and Career Institutions, or CTCI: at the postsecondary level, non-degree granting institutions are currently included in the scope of CTCI).

What is needed from you?

- Starting from 1 November, please alert your line manager or the Marketing department if you see any digital collateral with the CIHE-NEASC logo or name still in use.
- For customised material, please be sure to use the correct NECHE logo and language when referring to accreditation. You can find

the NECHE JPG and EPS logo, logo guidelines and language guidelines (Public Disclosure of Information, point 2) on <u>SEAM</u>.
